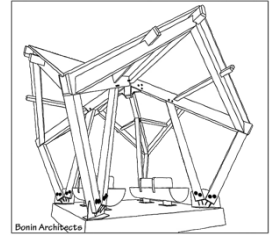
The ILBA is hosting a competition for the design of small structures that can be built during upcoming in-person log building workshops. The hands-on training sessions can be held at regional gatherings or pre-conference workshops.

The competition is open to all. ILBA membership is not a requirement to enter. There is **no entry fee**.

First prize is a yearlong ILBA Company membership or its cash equivalent. The contest is sponsored by David C. Rogers, owner of Logs & Timbers in Rhododendron, Oregon.

Ideas can be wide-ranging as shown in these images from a similar event in 2008 held by the Timber Framers Guild at Silver Park in Missoula, Montana. The structure is to use round and/or hewn logs. A roof is required.

Suggested ideas: picnic shelter, woodshed, gazebo, entry gate, sleeping shelter, kiosk, blacksmith shed, children's playhouse, covered firepit, smokehouse, garden shed, whatever... Have FUN with it!



Design Specifications:

- Dripline (edge of roof) to cover 300sf/28 sq m or less
- Plate height to be 8-9ft/2.44-2.74m
- Materials to be naturally tapered or hewn logs
- Plan may be any shape that can be roofed
- Window and door openings allowed
- Roof system to be pre-assembled on the ground
- Assembly/Dis-Assembly to be accomplished by two people
- NO heavy-lifting equipment to be allowed

- Proposal to be structurally sound
- Ground connections TBD
- Engineering to be later developed in relation to final location of structure

Submittal Requirements:

- Plan, Section & Elevations as **letter size pdfs**
- Perspective of model optional
- Entry form required
